Saint Valentine was a clergyman, either priest or bishop, who ministered to Christians that were being persecuted by the Romans. He was martyred on February 14th 269 AD. His body is buried at a Christian cemetery on the Via Flaminia near Rome. The Feast of Saint Valentine, known as Saint Valentine's Day, was established by Pope Gelasius I in 496 AD to be celebrated each year on February 14th.

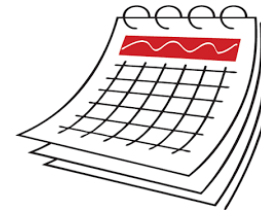
